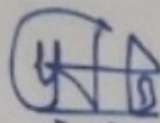

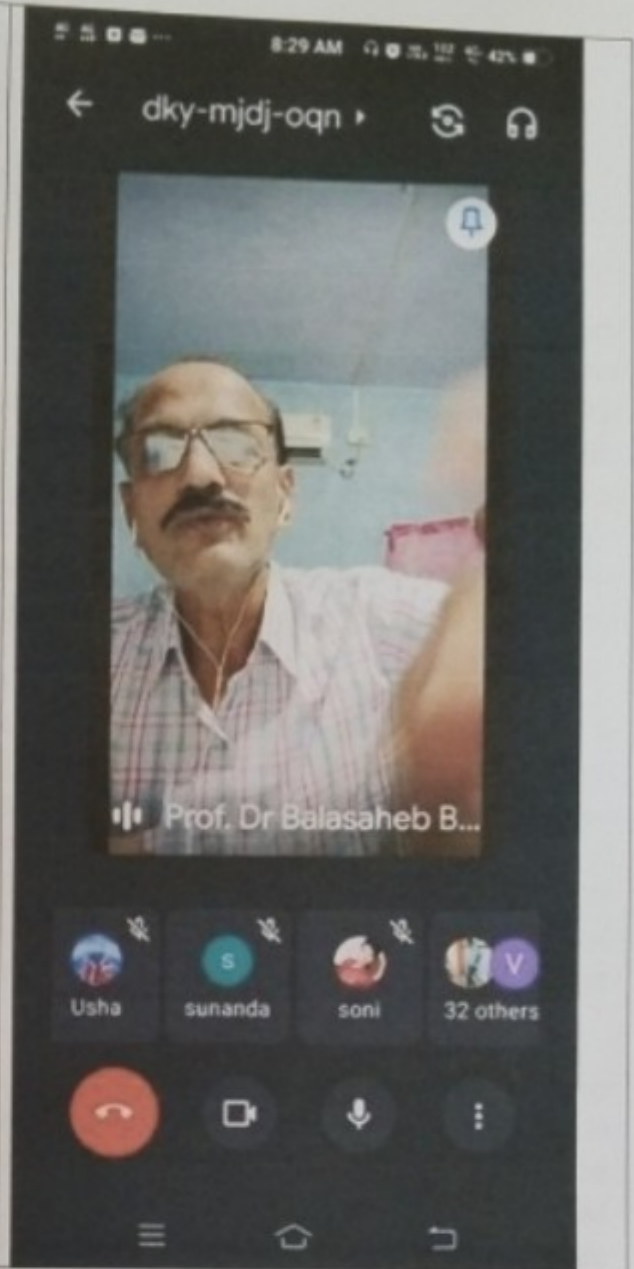
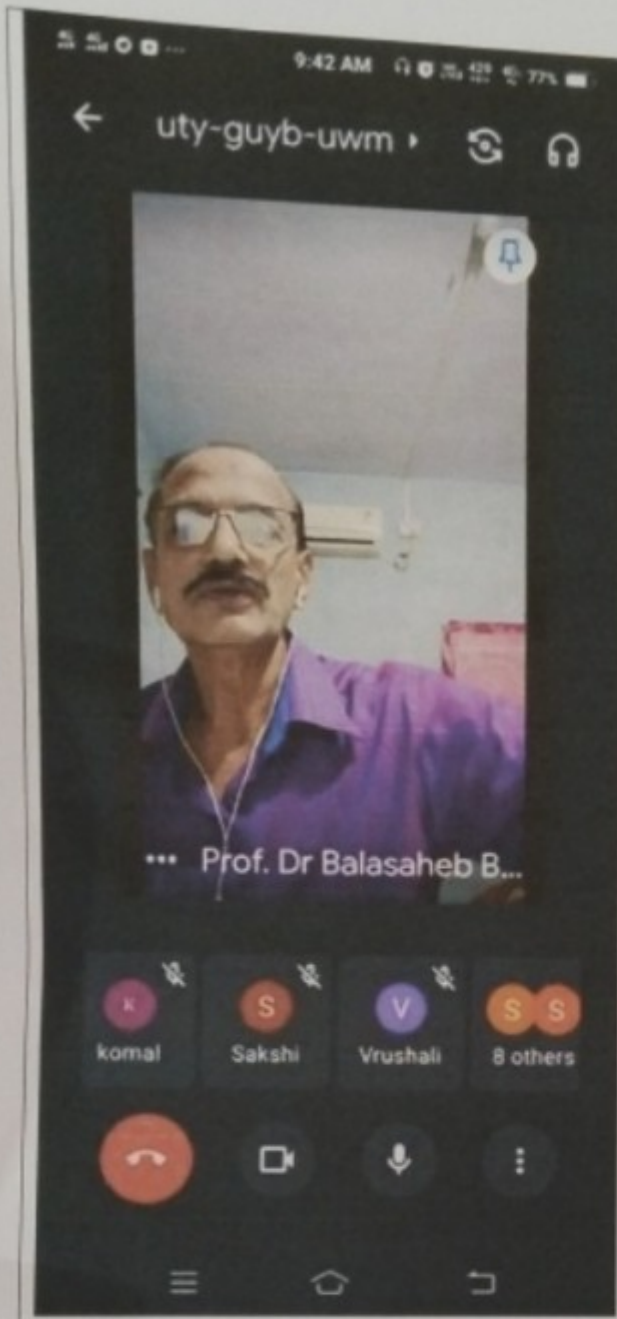
This program has been conducted for ten days. Through online lectures students understood the importance and necessity of soft skills in the business world.
