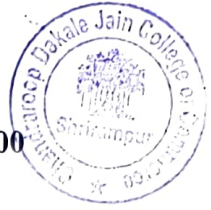

As well issue of books is also recorded completely with the help of **bar coding system**.

Almost all the classrooms are **ICT enabled**. The institute encourages all teachers to undergo training programs, to enhance their knowledge and use of ICT to deliver effective lectures using **PPTs, videos and animations**, prepared by teachers or available online. Several faculty members have their subject specific **Youtube channels**. A **database of Eresources** for all the courses is now available with the institute. 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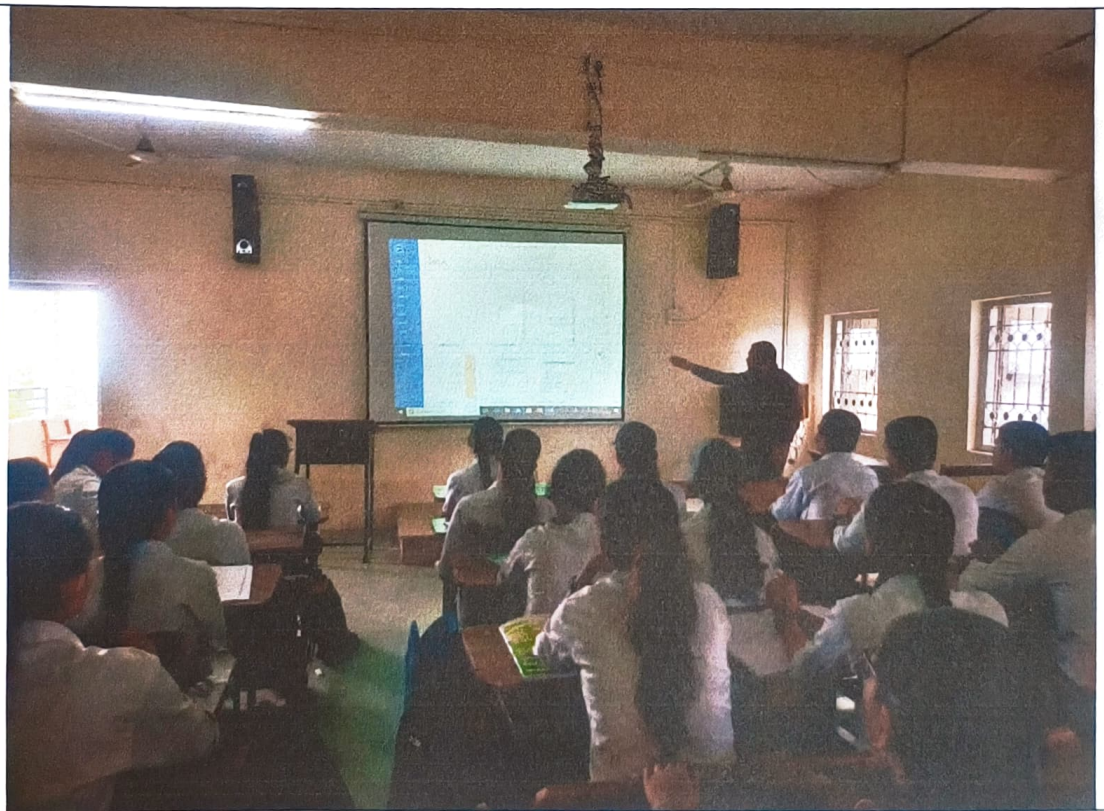

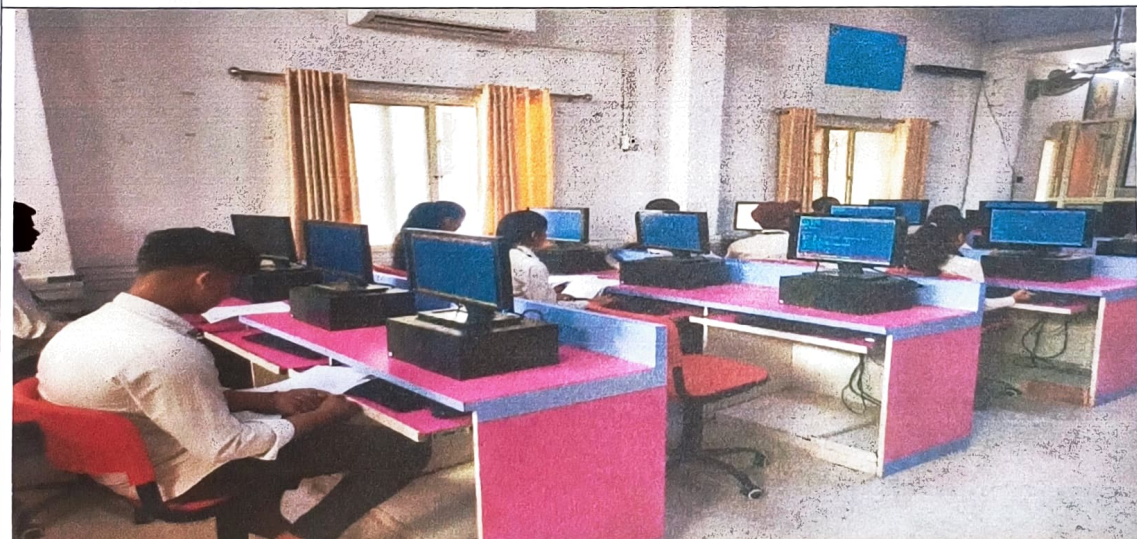
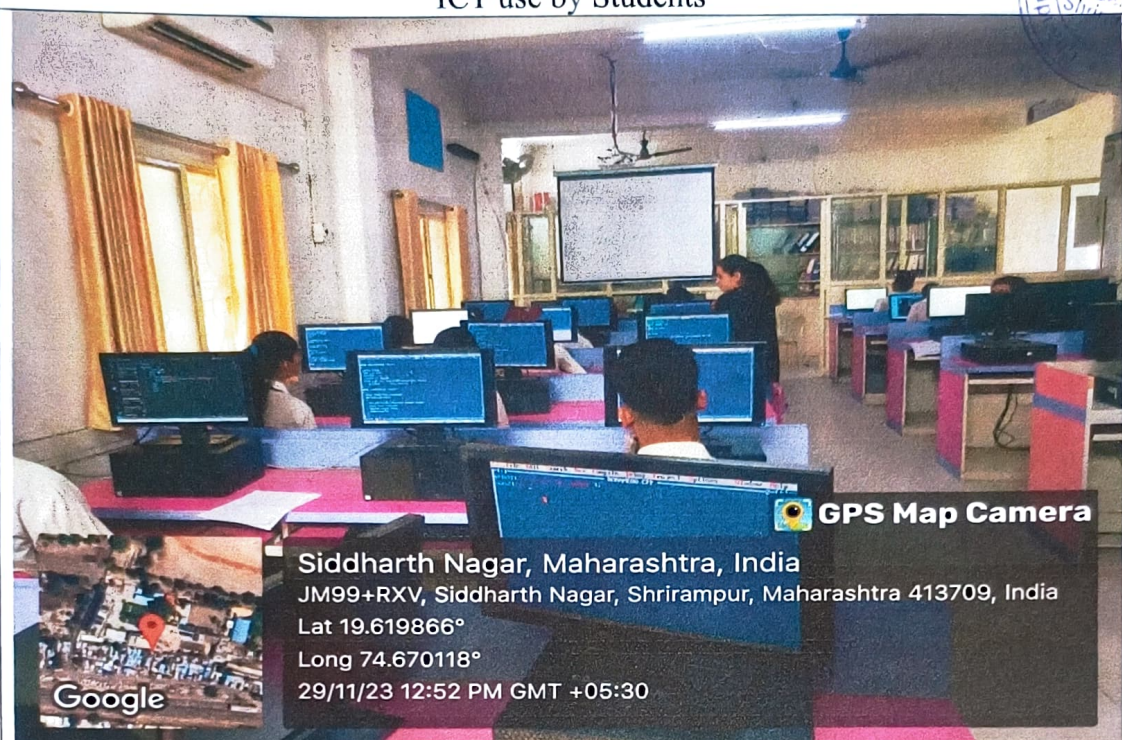


ICT Use by Faculty

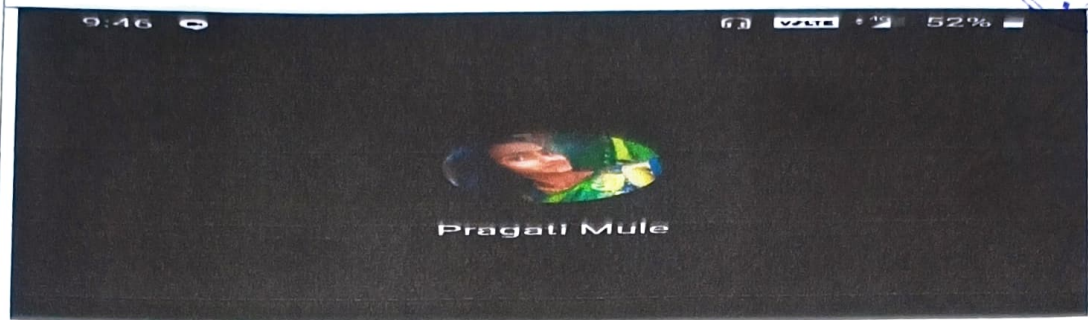
