→ Explain the types of reports in details.

• Meaning :-

The simple meaning of report is that, "It is only a summary of information". This is a written communication to the needy person about an activity, from a person who studies and also compiles the required from a required angle.

A report may be informative or fact finding.

• Types of Business Report

i] Informational reports :-

These reports present information as it is. They can do not contain any kind of interpretations and conclusions. The reports are an end in themselves.

The progress reports, final reports, operating reports, sales reports, interim reports are the common forms of the informational reports.



## 2] Analytical reports :-

These reports provide the data for analysis and the decision-making. They contain interpretations, conclusions and the suggestions.

These are the various types of business reports, that which can be classified in following ways.

A] On the basis of the legal formalities to be complied with, the reports which can be informal reports and the formal reports :-

### 1] Informal Reports :-

An informal reports is the usually in the form of a person to person of communication. An informal type of reports is usually submitted in the form of the letter or a memorandum.

### 2] Formal Reports :-

A formal reports is one which is prepared in prescribed form and is presented according to an established procedure to a prescribed authority.



a) Statutory reports :-

A report prepared and presented the according to the form and the procedure laid down by the law is called statutory report.

b) Non-Statutory reports :-

Formal reports, which are not the required under any law, but which are prepared to help the management in framing policies or taking other important decision are called as non-statutory reports.

B) On the basis of the frequency of issue, a report can be periodic or special :-

1) Periodic or Routine :-

Reports that are prepared and the presented at regular, prescribed intervals in the usual routine of a business firm. Branch managers of banks submit the periodic. The reports to the head office on the quantum of business transacted during a particular period.

2] Special Reports :-

Special reports are to be related to a single occasion or the situation. Special reports deal with non-recurrent problems.

3] Annual Reports :-

They are reports which are written annually, that is once in a year. The report of the current year and the prospectus in the next year are the year parts of an annual report.

c] On the basis of functions, a report can be informative or interpretative :-

1] Informative reports :-

Reports that merely present facts pertinent to an issue or the situation or the present production figures in a particular period, they are informative.



## 2] Interpretative Reports :-

They go into the causes of lower productions in the period. Become analytical, interpretative or investigative.

On the basis of the nature of the subject dealt with :-

### 1] Progress Reports :-

Progress reports are meant to describe and assess the program, made during a particular period.

### 2] Examination Reports :-

Examination reports are specially earmarked to cover important aspects. They are prepared after thorough investigation, old files are studied, by the personal interviews are held, questionnaires are circulated etc.

### 3] Recommendation Report :-

Recommendation reports can concluded with recommendations and such reports are argumentative and persuasive.

#### 4) Statistical Reports :-

Statistical reports are largely made up of financial data, the mathematical charts, tabular columns of figures etc.

#### 5) Problem-determining reports :-

In problem-determining report, the causes under-laying a problem or to ascertain whether or not the problem of actually exists is determined.

#### 6) Technical Reports :-

In a technical reports, data is presented on the specialised subject, with or without the comments.

#### 7) Fact-Finding Report :-

In a case of fact finding report, data is presented on a particular facts.

#### 8) Performance Report :-

In a performance Report, the purpose is to analyse the performance.



1] On the basis of the number of persons entrusted with the drafting of the report, reports can be reports by individuals and reports by the committees or the sub-committees :-

1] Reports by individuals :-

Reports submitted by the branch of the manager, personnel manager, marketing manager, the company secretary, the auditor, the solicitor, etc.

2] Reports by Committees or sub-committees :-

They are lengthier reports, which are included a table of contents and a synopsis etc.

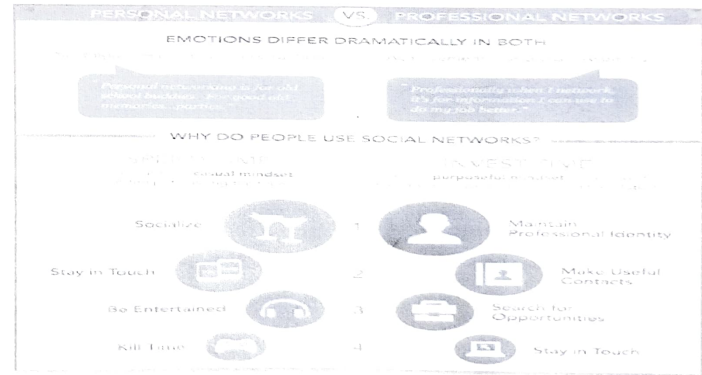
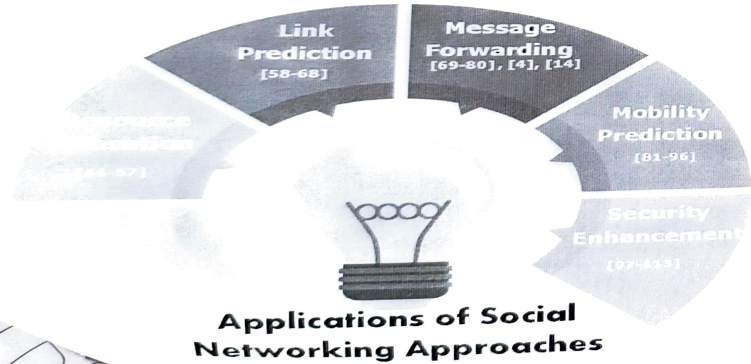
