**WHEREAS:**

**NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

**CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing entrepreneurial mindset which help student to decide entrepreneurship as a career choice keeping in mind the needs of the educational Institute, the Second Party.

- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
- 1.4 First Party will provide expertise and human resource for imparting entrepreneurial skills among stakeholders.
- 1.5 The orientation programme /sessions/workshops for entrepreneurial awareness will be organized at Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's, Chandraroop Dakle Jain College of Commerce, Shrirampur.
- 1.6 The study material, course information and other information of common interest will be shared mutually.

#### CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in economic development of the country through establishing enterprises. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** First Party will give valuable inputs to the Second Party in designing teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the current entrepreneurial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3 **Entrepreneurship Training & Visits:** Entrepreneurship training followed by industry visits will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of startups / enterprise setup. The entrepreneurship training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to entrepreneurial career. The Second Party will provide its Labs & training halls for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the field of Entrepreneurship.
- 2.5 **Entrepreneurship Development Programs:** First Party to conduct training programme for the students of Second Party on entrepreneurship development in order to disseminate the information and make students attitude to opt for entrepreneurship as a career choice.
- 2.6 **Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme:** First Party to extend the necessary support to conduct entrepreneurship awareness programmes to the students of the Second Party on emerging trends in entrepreneurship.
- 2.7 **Faculty Development Programs:** First Party to train the Faculties of Second Party for imparting training on entrepreneurship development funded by First Party.
- 2.8 **Udyojak Magazine:** Udyojak magazine is one of the tools for cultivating entrepreneurial culture in the society. Second party will help first party for promoting Udyojak Magazine at large extent to give the motto of magazine.
- 2.9 **Post Training support to Trained Students:** First Party will help actively in starting enterprise to the students of second party in terms of Business Plan Preparation, Marketing support, financial support from financial institutions, Design Support, Support for trial production, etc.

- 2.10 First Party will provide hands-on training and on job training to students of the college.
- 2.11 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.
- 2.12 There is no financial commitment on the part of the MCED, the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

### CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, stopped or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

### CLAUSE 4: VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period MCED, the First Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's, CHANDRAROOP DAKLE JAIN COLLEGE OF COMMERCE, SHRIRAMPUR. Tal- Shrirampur, Dist-Ahmednagar the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

### CLAUSE 5: RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that MCED and Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's, CHANDRAROOP DAKLE JAIN COLLEGE OF COMMERCE, SHRIRAMPUR. Tal- Shrirampur, Dist-Ahmednagar are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Whereas PMTSM and College have desired to work together towards guidance, coordination and convergence of all skill development schemes to outcome based Trainings, Assessments and Certification under PMKVY4.0 and setting working arrangement that each party agree to complete the project.

**1. Role and Responsibility of College**

- a. College will provide building Infrastructure to PMTSM for the organization of the sanctioned Courses exclusively.
- b. College shall keep this Project as Standalone Project and shall not combine or mix its working or Structure with other Workings or Projects.
- c. Mobilization of internal students for enrolment and binding the students to attend the classes regularly for the prescribed duration and mark the attendance on device provided by PMTSM.

**2. Role & Responsibility of PMTSM**

- a. PMTSM will be responsible for
  - i. All Center approvals from NSDC.
  - ii. All Targets Approvals from NSDC.
  - iii. Mobilization of external students for enrolment.
  - iv. Conduct skill based training courses for students (only for allocated target under the project.)
  - v. All Faculty & Trainers Salaries (Staff Associated to the Project).
  - vi. Assessment of Students.
  - vii. Management and keep up to date Data of attendance and assessment.
  - viii. Upload Data on Govt. Portal as necessary from time to time.
  - ix. Investing for purpose of project. All inventory purchased through such investment shall remain the property of PMTSM and PMTSM shall have right to retain all such inventories after completion of period of MOU.
  - x. Upon receiving payments related to the project from government, PMTSM agrees to transfer the funds to College within 2-3 working days. This transfer shall be carried out in the ratio described in clause 6.
  - xi. Make available all invoices or documents regarding payments and fund transfer for better transparency between PMTSM and College.
  - xii. Access to all government portals (Skill India Digital Portal) by sharing Login credentials pertaining to the project so as to monitor progress (Batches enrolled, Attendance, Results, Invoices & payment) shall be shared with College.

**Duration of Collaboration:** This agreement shall remain in force until the successful completion of the project or until December 31, 2026, whichever comes earlier. 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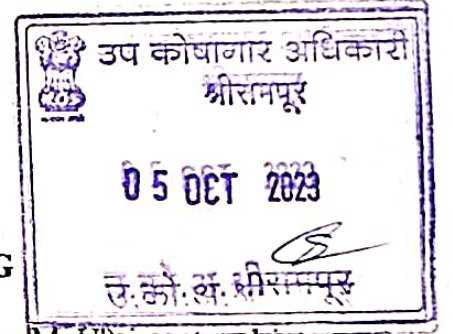

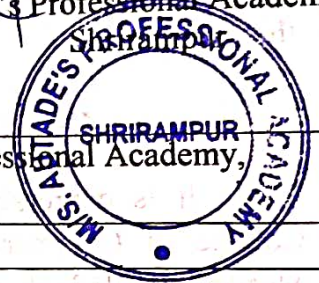
